- Purchase, store, prepare, and serve food to retain nutritional value and prevent contamination.
- Maintain necessary records of food orders and concerns regarding special diets or allergies.
- Maintain an inventory of kitchen equipment supplies and an inventory of food supplies.
- Maintain a good working relationship with all staff and Hub Centre programs.
- As support staff, should attend meetings and any relevant workshops when requested.
- Knowledge of the nutritional requirements of young children.
- Ability to follow recommendations and instructions regarding advice on special diets or allergies.
