## **RESPONSIBILITES:**

- Use Anishinaabemowin throughout the day in the assigned rooms and support ECEs.
- Co-plan with the assigned ECE Anishinaabe cultural activities. The classroom teacher will connect these cultural activities to Hub Centre programming expectations.
- Model and mentor Anishinaabemowin with the assigned classroom ECE to indirectly improve educator and staff acquisition of Anishinaabemowin.
- Connect with community agencies to coordinate learning during the day and advise on the ordering of necessary resources for lessons (i.e. Anishinaabe medicines, cultural activity resources).
- > Support programs, cultural activities, and land-based learning.
- Invite community Elders and Knowledge Keepers to be a part of the learning.
- Collaborate with the Wiikwemkoong Anishinaabemowin Kinoomaagewin Department for resources.
- Participate in all WBE professional development opportunities.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Minimum Grade 12 or equivalent.
- > Fluency in Anishinaabemowin is necessary.
- > Knowledge and appreciation of Anishinabek Culture, traditions, language, and history.
- Land-based learning skills are an asset.
