- Model and mentor Anishinaabemowin with the assigned classroom teacher to indirectly improve teacher acquisition of Anishinaabemowin.
- Connect with community agencies (Wiikwemkoong Lands Department, Wiikwemkoong Heritage Organization, community Knowledge Keepers, etc.) to coordinate learning during some of these classes.
- Advise on ordering necessary resources for lessons (i.e., Anishinaabe medicines, cultural activity resources).
- Invite community Elders and Knowledge Keepers to be a part of the learning.
- Collaborate with the Wiikwemkoong Anishinaabemowin Kinoomaagewin Department for resources.

- Knowledge and appreciation of Anishinaabek Culture, Traditions, Language, and History.
