- Implement developmentally appropriate curriculum and daily program activities in accordance with the Wikwemikong Board of Education pedagogical philosophy, and Ministry of Education requirements.
- Ensure the consistent inclusion of Anishinaabemowin language and Anishinaabe cultural activities within daily program delivery.
- Support and guide children's physical, social, emotional, cognitive, and language development through responsive interactions, observation, and play-based learning experiences.
- Provide consistent and attentive supervision to ensure the safety, health, and well-being of all children during indoor and outdoor program activities.
- Plan, organize, implement, and coordinate daily activities and learning environments within the assigned classroom or program area, in accordance with staff schedules.
- Maintain accurate and confidential records, observations, and daily program documentation, including journals and child-related information, in accordance with policy requirements.
- Adhere to assigned job responsibilities, schedules, Ministry of Education – Child Care Early Years Act and procedures, the WUT and WBE policies.
